



SIXTH FORM UNIFORM

Adcote Sixth Form prepares our young ladies for their future professional lives. The uniform code requires each student to dress smartly and respectably in an appropriate business suit.

Our experience tells us that there are many variations to the term 'business suit'; therefore we have prepared this guide to ensure you have selected an appropriate uniform for your years at Adcote.

Uniform Code

- You may wear either a skirt or a trouser suit.
- Your suit must be either dark blue, navy blue, black, grey or charcoal.
- Blouses are to be worn with the suit. They must be plain and either white, cream or pale colours.

Regulation Length and Style

- We expect skirts to be worn on the knee. Miniskirts are **not** acceptable.
- Shoes must be plain black or grey with heels no more than 5cm. Heels must **not** be stiletto style as the flooring in school is easily damaged by narrow heeled shoes.

Clothing for Winter Weather

In the winter students are encouraged to wear thermal underwear or a sleeved top with a shirt worn over it. Wool jackets are much warmer than polyester and this might be more suitable for the winter months.

- Winter coats may be worn when moving between the buildings but they must **not** be worn in class or assembly.
- Scarves are **not** to be worn inside.
- Jeans or black denim trousers are **not** acceptable as uniform.
